Policies for Community Participation in Radio Operations of Montreal Community Theatre Inc. 2TVR

1. We will promote the benefits of membership widely, such as through on-air announcements, membership drives, website / social media, distributing flyers at outdoor broadcasts and community events, notices on community bulletin boards, and articles in the local press. Importantly, through day to day on air activities using pre recorded and live mentions and discussions.

2. Where possible, we will include non-member volunteers in all areas of operations including technical, programming, management and on air.
3. We will continue seeking feedback from the community via Social Media, surveys, emails, website, requests, in person and at regional venue and event attendance.
4. We will engage interested member and non member volunteers from the wider community to participate in events, attend meetings and participate in running of the station.
5. We will continue to provide radio presentation and production training to all interested people from our region.
6. We will continue to engage with local musicians and encourage them to participate in events and volunteer as important members of the stations operations and activities.
7. We will continue to engage with community groups and schools through training opportunities, outside broadcasts, work experience and community service announcements.
8. We will document statistics on membership; member and non-member volunteer involvement and provide these as part of the Management Report at the Annual General Meeting.
9. We will continue to encourage community participation in our program selection through the committee, through feedback from the community and discussions with volunteers. Importantly for those wishing to remain anonymous and contribute that way, we will promote extensively our well used Radio Reaction Hotline number and service.
10. 2TVR will actively cover local news, events, activities and issues through community service announcements, interviews with local community members and through our social media channels. Importantly, through our broadcasts we will remain and encourage active participation in the provision of the broadcasting service.
